Checkmate Xplorer Harness

The Checkmate Xplorer harness has been developed for the adventure leisure market, but is also suitable for use in a wide range of industrial applications. The harness is designed to be more comfortable than a conventional harness for short periods of suspension and frequent loadings as common in adventure activities.



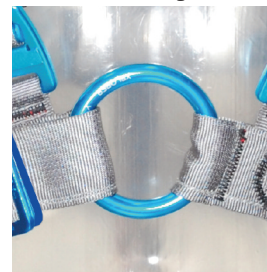
Alert Stitching

An intuitive way for the harness to effectively communicate with the user or supervisor, the underside or covered stitch patterns are all in bright red. If you see red stitching this indicates incorrect donning.



Limited Slip Rear D

Designed for multiple loadings with a small amount of vertical adjustment built in. Because the D is limited to a max of 50mm adjustment it stops strap migration.



Large Front Ring

Large front attachment ring for multiple connections. The key-way entry exit buckle with velcro security wrap ensures a safe final connection.



Hardware

Specifically designed to be ergonomically suited to the product functions, reducing wear on the webbing, allowing easy connections and critical pivot points give greater articulation.



Curved Webbing

Unique curved webbing follows the contours of the body for a closer fit.



Sub-Pelvic Assembly

Innovative construction for greater support and increased comfort when suspended.
